**ALIZE ROZSNYAI**, a soprano “displaying profound imagination and control” (Philadelphia Inquirer), is a recent graduate of the Curtis Institute of Music, and known as a versatile artist, adept at musical theatre, baroque and contemporary repertoire. Recently, she appeared at Carnegie Hall as soloist in Berio’s *Sinfonia*, and the Kennedy Center performing her own original English translation of Schönberg’s *Pierrot Lunaire*, with Curtis. A passionate interpreter of new works, Alize originated the roles of Lila in Jennifer Higdon’s *Cold*

*Mountain*, First Andy in *Andy: a Popera*, Silvana in *A Flourish of Green* (Mazzoli), all workshoped with Opera Philadelphia, and covered the title role in Louis Karchin’s *Jane Eyre* with the Center for Contemporary Opera. Having performed over 20 leading roles, favorite company credits include the International Gilbert & Sullivan Festival, in Harrogate, England, Rossini Opera Festival in Pesaro, Italy, Chautauqua Opera, San Diego Opera, San Diego Lyric Opera, and Den Nye Opera of Bergen, Norway.
