DANIELLE SINCLAIR has performed with orchestras throughout the country in works ranging from Bach's *Magnificat* and St. John Passion to Respighi's *Lauda per la Natività del Signore* and Orff's *Carmina Burana*. She has appeared in numerous operatic roles including Musetta in *La Bohème*, Despina in *Così fan tutte*, Zerlina in *Don Giovanni*, Gretel in *Hansel and Gretel* and Mabel in *Pirates of Penzance*. In 1990 she won Seattle's 200+1 Vocal Competition, and in 1995 the prestigious Opera at Florham Guild Competition. Ms. Sinclair has been a frequent guest artist in Westminster Conservatory's concert and recital series and performs regularly with the Princeton Society of Musical Amateurs. In 2004 she performed in the ensemble of the world premiere performance of Charles Wuorinen's opera *Haroun and the Sea of Stories* with New York City Opera. She can also be heard as soloist on the Seattle Symphony Chorale's recording *Singing a Glad Noel*.
