

# Edward McCall

## *Conductor*



**W. EDWARD MCCALL** is the Director of Music at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Doylestown and Artistic Director of Cantus Novus, a premier chamber choir based in Bucks County, PA. Mr. McCall has served on the faculties of Westminster Choir College, Temple University and St. Michael's Choir School in Toronto, Canada. He was the Director of Choral Activities for high school and junior high schools at the Council Rock School District in Newtown, PA for many years.

Mr. McCall has prepared and directed choirs for national television appearances, professional recordings, symphony appearances, choral festivals, national tours, and a Papal visit. In the United States, choirs under Mr. McCall's direction performed at several PMEA All-State Conventions to enthusiastic acclaim. He has coordinated and directed dozens of choir tours including a ten day odyssey to the People's Republic of China.

Choral reviews by Mr. McCall have been published in the Choral Journal and articles relating to choral-orchestral works were published in the Canadian choral journal Anacrusis. He adjudicates at choral festivals in the United States and Canada.

Mr. McCall has served for many years on the Board of Directors of the Pennsylvania Chapter American Choral Directors Association and on the Board of Directors for Choirs Ontario.

He holds a Master of Music in Choral Conducting and Music Education from Westminster Choir College in Princeton, NJ. Mr. McCall studies include courses with Joseph Flummerfelt, Constatina, Tsoulainu, Alan Crowell, Frauke Hasemann, Sir David Wilcocks, John Rutter, Rodney Eichenberger, and Andre Thomas.

In addition to his many musical endeavours, Mr. McCall is a travel consultant in New York City for choral groups performing at Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center.
