JACK ZAMBONI has appeared as a soloist with numerous choral groups in New Jersey and Pennsylvania, including many Sunday afternoons with PSMA. He also has given recitals throughout the Northeast. In addition to his concert work, he has performed Tamino in Mozart's *The Magic Flute* with Trenton State College Opera Theater, as well as Goro in *Madama Butterfly* and Spoletta in *Tosca* with Boheme Opera, NJ. His vocal training includes study at Yale University, the Aspen Music Festival, the Berkshire Music Festival at Tanglewood, and Westminster Choir College. A versatile singer whose repertoire extends from early music to 20th century composers, he has been praised for his expressive singing and the warmth and beauty of his voice. When he is not singing, Jack is the Rector of St. Francis' Episcopal Church in Dunellen, New Jersey.
