JOCELYN COLAO is a graduate of Westminster Choir College, where she was a student of Sharon Sweet. This is her fifth appearance with the Princeton Society of Musical Amateurs. Ms. Colao has performed scenes from Strauss's *Der Rosenkavalier*, Delibes' *Lakme*, and Mozart's *Le Nozze di Figaro*, had her solo professional debut in the Spoleto Music Festival's production of Charpentier's *Louise* and has appeared as a soloist with the Westminster Chapel Choir, Schola Cantorum, Williamson Voices, and the world-renowned Westminster Choir. Ms. Colao is the Executive Assistant for the Continuo Arts Foundation, where she has also been a featured soloist, and will be a part of the Continuo Arts Symphonic Chorus, which will be the first American Choir to perform a concert in the Sistine Chapel this February. Ms. Colao is also a member of the All Saints' Choir in Princeton, NJ, where she performed as a mezzo soloist in Mozart's *Requiem*.
