JOHN WILSON has served as the choral director at Bridgewater-Raritan High School for thirteen years. Since 2014, Mr. Wilson served on the faculty at the High School Vocal Institute of Westminster Choir, where he leads choral ensembles and teaches a primer in conducting. John was also a conducting fellow at the 2014 Yale School of Music Choral Conducting Workshop, held in Norfolk, Connecticut, where he worked with Simon Carrington. In June of 2014, Mr. Wilson worked with Harold Farberman, Guillermo Figueroa, and Eduardo Navega at Bard College's Orchestral Conducting Institute. From 2015-2018, John was an Associate Director at the prestigious Princeton Girlchoir organization, where he conducted the high school aged Cantores ensemble. Mr. Wilson has taught courses in music education as part time lecturer at Rutgers University, where he received his Master's Degree in Choral Conducting. He is currently pursuing his DMA in Choral Conducting at Rutgers.
