Other credits include performances with the Central City Opera in Colorado.

Lisa's professional experience extends to musical theater, performing roles with Colorado's Creede Repertory Theater, the Arvada Center for the Arts and Humanities, and in New Jersey with The Growing Stage. As a chorister, Lisa has sung at venues in Vienna and Graz, Austria, Venice, and with the Richard Alston Dance Company in London's Sadler's Wells Theatre. She also sang the Verdi Requiem and Mahler's 3rd Symphony with the NJSO.

Lisa studies voice with Dr. Peter Gillis (MSU) and is a member of Actors' Equity. She is happy to be singing again with the Princeton Society of Musical Amateurs.
