She has served as Assistant Professor of Music Education at the Westminster Choir College of Rider University and Conductor of the Resident Training Choir at the American Boychoir School in Princeton, New Jersey. Ms. Jenkins is a choral conductor and music educator of international stature, having lectured and conducted in China, Hong Kong, Iceland, and South Africa. She has earned degrees from Temple University and

Westminster Choir College of Rider University, and at both institutions was awarded the Elaine Brown Conducting Award. She is a candidate for a doctor of musical arts degree in choral conducting at the University of Arizona in Tucson.
