**Zerrin Agabigum Martin**, *mezzo-soprano*, is active as a conductor and performer. As the Director of Choral and Vocal Music at the Tower Hill School in Delaware, she has also held the position of Director of the Trouvères and Troubador choirs with the Pennsylvania Girlchoir in Philadelphia. Recent engagements include Copland's *In the Beginning*, Handel's *Messiah*, Mendelssohn's *Elijah*, Haydn's *Lord Nelson Mass*, Mozart's *Coronation Mass*, Buxtehude's *Membra Jesu Nostri*, and Bach's *St. Matthew Passion*.

An avid ensemble singer, she has performed with numerous choral ensembles, such as the Norfolk Music Festival Chamber Choir, The Crossing, Westminster Choir, Westminster Kantorei, and the JSB Ensemble of the Internationale Bachakademie in Stuttgart. She regularly performs with twice Grammy®-nominated Seraphic Fire, Tucson Chamber Artists, and the Oregon Bach Festival Berwick Chorus. Ms. Martin holds degrees in

voice performance and choral conducting, respectively from the University of Michigan and Westminster Choir College.
