An active choral singer, **MICHAEL MCCORMICK** has performed alongside orchestras such as The Philadelphia Orchestra and New York Philharmonic for pieces including Benjamin Britten's *War Requiem*, Mozart's *Mass in C Minor*, and Handel's *Messiah*. He has also sung with groups such as the Choir at Christ Church NYC, St. Bartholomew's Choir NYC, Beloit Chorale, and Sonare. A former member of the Westminster Choir, Michael toured both domestically and internationally, sang at Spoleto Festival USA, and recorded an album featuring Frank Martin's *Mass for Double Choir*. His solo appearances include Handel's *Messiah* at Zion Lutheran Church in Rome, NY and Lord Tolloller in Gilbert and Sullivan's *Iolanthe* at Westminster Choir College. Later this month, he will be featured as the tenor soloist with the Rutgers University Kirkpatrick Choir for a performance of Haydn's *Creation Mass*. Currently, Michael is pursuing a Masters degree in Choral Conducting at Rutgers University, and is the Director of Music at St. Mark's Episcopal Church in Basking Ridge, NJ.
