GREGORY JON GEEHERN, D.Mus., is a young conductor acclaimed for using creativity and innovation to bring choral music to a new generation of audiences.

A multi-talented choral conductor, pianist, baritone/tenor and scholar, Geehern has been called a "gifted new presence" for his work with full choirs, opera choruses and chamber ensembles in repertoire from the Middle Ages to the present day.

For ten seasons, Geehern was part of the Princeton Festival's artistic team, where he served as assistant conductor and chorus master of John Adams' *Nixon in China*, Puccini's *Madama Butterfly*, Beethoven's *Fidelio*, Benjamin Britten's *Peter Grimes* and Richard Wagner's *Der fliegende Holländer*. He has also served as assistant conductor of George Gershwin's *Porgy & Bess* and Mozart's *Le nozze di Figaro*.
