LISA ANDREACCHI, mezzo-soprano, holds a baccalaureate degree in voice performance from Metropolitan University of Denver, and a Masters of Arts in Teaching (music) from Montclair State University (MSU). As a soloist, Lisa has performed in *Alzheimer's Stories* with the MSU Chorale, Britten's *A Ceremony of Carols* with the Richard Alston Dance Company, and in Mendelssohn's *A Midsummer Night's Dream* with the New Jersey Symphony Orchestra (NJSO). Other credits include performances with Colorado's Central City Opera, and the Colorado Symphony. Lisa's professional experience extends to musical theater, performing roles with Colorado's Creede Repertory Theater, the Arvada Center for the Arts and Humanities, and in New Jersey with The Growing Stage: The Children's Theater of New Jersey. As a chorister, Lisa has sung at venues in Vienna and Graz, Austria, Venice, with the Richard Alston Dance Company in London's Sadler's Wells Theatre, and at Carnegie Hall in NYC. Other choral performances include the Verdi Requiem and Mahler's 3rd Symphony with the NJSO. Lisa studies voice with Dr. Peter Gillis (MSU) and is a member of Actors' Equity.
