Soprano **Sophia Huellstrunk** received her bachelor's degree in mathematics from Princeton University with a minor in vocal consort performance. She performed the Queen of the Night in *The Magic Flute*, appeared in opera scenes including Delibes' *Flower Duet*, and sang *Rejoice Greatly, O Daughter of Zion* in a *Messiah* sing-along held in the Princeton Chapel. She curated and performed both a junior and senior recital featuring repertoire ranging from Baroque to Classical, including Delibes' "*Bell Song*" and Mozart's *Durch Zärtlichkeit und Schmeicheln*. She sang and soloed with Chamber V choir, Glee Club, and consort ensembles. Last May, she performed solos on the Glee Club's interational tour to Spain and Portugal, including featured solos in Toby's *Path of Miracles* and Ramírez's *Misa Criolla*.

Currently, while pursuing a PhD in mathematics at the University of Pennsylvania, she is on the roster of the Philadelphia Symphonic Chorus and serves as the Alto I section leader at the Presbyterian Church of Chestnut Hill. This season, she will be performing *Messiah* with PCCH as well as guest singing with the West Jersey Chamber Chorale. She recently premiered a Japanese song cycle titled *Two Haiku* at NYU and gave a concert featuring works by Mozart, Handel, and Clara Schumann. She has been a longtime participant in Musical Amateurs.
